$\star$ Just discovered GRM but have aged out of the camps

## Costs and Schedule:

Each two week session is $\$ 350$
Session 1: July 10-21
Session 2: July 24-August 5
Session 3: August 7-18
Session 4: August 14-25 (KBG and WS only)

## Selecting Crade Levels

Camp grade levels are for your child's rising grade. You will register for the grade level your child is entering in the fall of 2023.

Primary camps are for campers entering 1st to 3rd grade
1-2 Purple Level: Going into $1^{\text {st }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade (currently in kindergarten or first grade) Pink Level: Going into $2^{\text {nd }}$ or $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade (currently in first or second grade)


Intermediate camps are for campers entering 3rd to 6th grade
Green Level: Going into $3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ or $5^{\text {th }}$ grade (currently in second, third or fourth grade) Blue Level: Going into $4^{\text {th }}, 5^{\text {th }}$ or $6^{\text {th }}$ grade (currently in third, fourth or fifth grade)

The Girls Rock Math Teen Leadership Program provides rising $\mathbf{9}^{\text {th }} \mathbf{- 1 2}^{\text {th }}$ graders with training and experience to take their leadership skills to the next level, all while earing service hours and volunteer hours required for high school graduation.

By becoming a Teen Leader with Girls Rock Math, high school students develop valuable life skills as a counselor that will help prepare them for college and future job opportunities.

Teen leaders will spend two weeks as counselors where they mentor campers by coaching them through fun and engaging math activities, help them forge friendships, gain confidence and see their true potential in STEM! Before May 1, you may cancel with full refund, minus the $\$ 75$ deposit.
No refunds after May 1. Cancelations made 3 weeks in advance of camp will receive credit, less the deposit. We will always transfer camp weeks free of charge. See policies on the website for details.

## Scholanship Information

Girls Rock Math recognizes the importance of providing access to our program to any girl or family who has the desire to attend camp, regardless of economic background. The Girls Rock Math Scholarship Fund provides reduced rate tuition for summer camp to members of the community who would not otherwise have the financial means to attend camp. We encourage anyone who would benefit from this aid to apply early, as our scholarships are first come, first serve.


## BIPOC Equity Access

In order to provide opportunity to those who are the furthest from STEM Equity, Girls Rock Math dedicates a portion of each scholarship donation to our BIPOC Equity Access Scholarship recipients. These scholarships are offered specifically to those who identify as part of the BIPOC community and can cover up to $100 \%$ of the cost of camp.

About the Camp Day: Each day begins with a problem-solving activity and morning meeting. There are three daily activity blocks with arts-based, hands-on math projects and games (60-90 minutes each) with a recess in between each session. In addition to the math activities, there is a daily read aloud about a woman in STEM and a daily Circle-Up which focuses on social/leadership skills, STEM careers and other confidence building activities. Each day ends with afternoon choice activities, an extra recess or special project time. We wrap up each day with reflection and songs.

*Daily drop-in care available if space allows, payable with Venmo, cash, or check.
